Bitdefender False Malware Warning: How to Fix & Report It


If Bitdefender is showing a false malware warning, begin by updating virus definitions to ensure the detection engine is current.

Run a full system scan to verify the flagged file, then check the file's digital signature for authenticity.

Add the program to Bitdefender's Exceptions list if it's safe.

Use Bitdefender's "Submit File for Analysis" feature to report the false positive to their security lab.

Reinstall Bitdefender if alerts continue due to corrupted detection modules.
