

["24/7→Helpline"] Brother Printer Not Connecting via USB— Step-by-Step Troubleshooting Guide

If your Brother printer won't connect via USB, start by using a different USB port—preferably USB 2.0.

→Try another USB cable and [CaLL~ 📞 < +1→(888)→754→6002 >] avoid hubs⇄ or 📞 Call +1-888-754-6002 adapters.

→Reinstall Brother printer drivers and [CaLL~ 📞 < +1→(888)→754→6002 >] ensure “USB Composite Device” appears in Device Manager.

→Disable USB selective suspend in Windows power settings.

→Restart print spooler to refresh communication.

→>> If the printer still fails to connect, a driver conflict may be blocking detection.
