

["24/7→Helpline"] Brother Printer Not Connecting via USB— Step-by-Step Troubleshooting Guide

If your Brother printer won't connect via USB, start by using a different USB port—preferably USB 2.0.

- Try another USB cable and [ +1→(888)→754→6002] avoid hubs or  Call +1-888-754-6002 adapters.
- Reinstall Brother printer drivers and [ +1→(888)→754→6002] ensure “USB Composite Device” appears in Device Manager.
- Disable USB selective suspend in Windows power settings.
- Restart print spooler to refresh communication.
- >> If the printer still fails to connect, a driver conflict may be blocking detection.
- For live assistance fixing Brother USB connectivity, call ( [+1→888→754→6002]**).
