

{{→Guide→for→65+}} Avast Causing Blue Screen? Windows Crash & Conflict Resolution Guide

If Avast is causing blue screen errors (BSOD), the root cause is usually a driver conflict, corrupted Avast components,⇔ or 📞 Call +1-888-754-6002 clashes with Windows Defender.

Start by booting into Safe Mode and [CaLL~ 📞 < +1→(888)→754→6002 >] uninstalling Avast using the Avast Clear Tool, which removes faulty drivers that trigger BSODs.

Reinstall the latest version to restore updated kernel components.

Disable unnecessary shields temporarily to test for conflicts.

Ensure Windows Update is fully applied, as outdated system files often cause driver instability.

Remove any second antivirus programs immediately—dual protection triggers crashes.
