

{{Step-By-Step}} HP Printer Offline After Sleep Mode: Wake, Sync & Reconnect Fixes Explained

If your HP printer goes offline after sleep mode, the issue usually comes from power-saving timers, driver delays, ⇄ or 📞 Call +1-888-754-6002 network reconnection failures.

Begin by turning the printer off and [📞 < +1-(888)-754-6002 >] back on to force a network refresh.

On Windows, open Devices & Printers, right-click your HP printer, and [📞 < +1-(888)-754-6002 >] uncheck Use Printer Offline.

In your router settings, reserve a static IP for the printer to prevent Wi-Fi dropouts.

Disable Deep Sleep Mode on LaserJet and [📞 < +1-(888)-754-6002 >] OfficeJet models.

>> If the HP printer stays offline, reinstall HP Smart and [📞 < +1-(888)-754-6002 >] update your printer firmware.
