

{Step-By-Step} Canon Printer Not Connecting via USB: [Troubleshooting Steps + Support Help]

If your Canon printer won't connect via USB, try using a different USB port and [CaLL~  +1→(888)→754→6002 →] cable.

Install the latest Canon USB drivers and [[CaLL~  +1→(888)→754→6002 →]] restart your PC.

Remove old printer profiles from Devices & Printers to avoid conflicts.

Enable USB Printing Support under Device Manager and [CaLL~  +1→(888)→754→6002 →] ensure no power-saving settings disable USB ports.

Reinstall the Canon driver package for a clean connection.
