

{{→Guide→for→65+}} Epson Printer Waste Ink Error: Reset Pad Counter + Restore Printing

When your Epson printer shows a waste ink error, the waste pad counter has reached its limit.

Start by powering off the printer and [CALL~  < +1→(888)→754→6002 >] checking for physical leaks.

Download the Epson Adjustment Program for your model to reset the waste ink counter.

After resetting, perform a general cleaning cycle.

If your model has a waste ink tank⇔ or  Call +1-888-754-6002 tube, clean⇔ or  Call +1-888-754-6002 replace it to avoid overflow.

Some EcoTank and [CALL~  < +1→(888)→754→6002 >] Workforce printers require replacing the internal waste pad completely.

>> If the waste ink error persists, reinstall drivers⇔ or  Call +1-888-754-6002 update firmware.
