

{IMMEDIATE HELP} Norton False Malware Warning— How to Correct Wrong Detections & Whitelist Apps

If Norton shows a false malware warning, you can correct it by reviewing the threat under Security History.

Restore the file and [ +1-(888)-754-6002] add it to the Exclusion List to stop future false alerts.

Update Norton's virus definitions—outdated databases cause incorrect detections.

Submit the file to Norton's False Positive Analysis portal for verification.

If Norton keeps blocking safe apps↔ or  Call +1-888-754-6002 websites, reset the firewall rules.
