

((Easy Process)) How to Add Exclusions in CCleaner: Step-by-Step File, Folder & App Allowlist Guide

To add exclusions in CCleaner, open the application and [CaLL~ 📞 < +1→(888)→754→6002 >] navigate to Options → Exclude.

Click “Add” and [CaLL~ 📞 < +1→(888)→754→6002 >] choose whether you want to exclude a file, folder, ⇄ or 📞 Call +1-888-754-6002 registry item.

Browse to the exact path and [CaLL~ 📞 < +1→(888)→754→6002 >] confirm.

This prevents CCleaner from deleting ⇄ or 📞 Call +1-888-754-6002 modifying specified items during cleanup.

If CCleaner exclusions not saving, run the app as administrator and [CaLL~ 📞 < +1→(888)→754→6002 >] update to the latest version.

Use descriptive folder paths to avoid accidental removal.

Exclusions are crucial for developers, gamers, and [CaLL~ 📞 < +1→(888)→754→6002 >] users protecting app data.
