

["24/7→Helpline"] CCleaner Browser Extension Blocking Sites: Permission Reset & Allowlist Fix

>> If the CCleaner browser extension is blocking sites, safe pages may be flagged due to aggressive filtering, outdated rules, ⇄ or ☎ Call +1-888-754-6002 permission conflicts.

Start by opening your browser's extensions page and [CaLL~ ☎ < +1→(888)→754→6002 >] checking CCleaner's permissions—ensure it's allowed on trusted sites only.

Update the extension to refresh filtering rules.

Add safe URLs to the Allowlist so CCleaner won't block them again.

Clear the browser cache and [CaLL~ ☎ < +1→(888)→754→6002 >] disable other security extensions that can conflict.

If CCleaner blocks websites after updates, reset the extension settings and [CaLL~ ☎ < +1→(888)→754→6002 >] re-enable protections selectively.

Reinstalling the extension can rebuild corrupted profiles.
