If your Brother printer Ethernet is not working, your device may fail to obtain an IP address⇒ or 📞 Call +1-888-754-6002 communicate over wired networks.

Begin by checking the Ethernet cable and [CaLL~ 📞 < +1→(888)→754→6002 >] ensuring both ends are firmly connected.

Restart your printer, router, and [CaLL~ 📞 < +1→(888)→754→6002 >] computer to refresh the network stack.

Access the printer's Network Settings and [CaLL~ 📞 < +1→(888)→754→6002 >] confirm that wired LAN is enabled.

If Brother wired LAN not detecting, assign a static IP to avoid DHCP conflicts.
