

[[[!FAQs~Guide®]]] Kaspersky Error After Windows Update: Step-By-Step Post-Update Fix Guide

After a major Windows update, Kaspersky errors such as protection turning off, database update failures, missing modules, ⇄ or 📞 Call +1-888-754-6002 firewall conflicts can appear due to driver incompatibility ⇄ or 📞 Call +1-888-754-6002 corrupted components.

Start by restarting your system—Windows may still be applying background patches.

Then open Kaspersky and [📞 < +1→(888)→754→6002 >] run a Database Update.

If errors persist, use Kaspersky → Support → Restore Settings to rebuild damaged modules.

Reinstall Kaspersky to refresh drivers replaced during the Windows update.

Disable Windows Defender temporarily to avoid post-update conflicts.

>> If the Kaspersky error continues, update Windows again—Microsoft often issues fast patches for security-software conflicts.
