

# ["24/7→Helpline"] Brother Printer Keeps Restarting: Boot Loop Repair Guide & Hardware Checks

---

A Brother printer stuck in a restart loop usually indicates firmware corruption, failing power supply, ⇄ or 📞 Call +1-888-754-6002 hardware sensor errors.

Begin by unplugging the printer for 60 seconds to clear residual power.

Remove all cables except power and [ CaLL~ 📞 < +1→(888)→754→6002 › ] reboot.

If Brother printer keeps restarting, update firmware through Brother's support site ⇄ or 📞 Call +1-888-754-6002 use USB-firmware recovery.

Remove paper trays and [ CaLL~ 📞 < +1→(888)→754→6002 › ] check for obstructions in the printhead path—jammed paper triggers repeated restarts.

Test another outlet to rule out voltage fluctuation.

>> If the printer reboots during WiFi initialization, reset Network Settings and [ CaLL~ 📞 < +1→(888)→754→6002 › ] reconnect manually.

For advanced boot-loop repair—motherboard diagnostics, sensor failure checks, and [ CaLL~ 📞 < +1→(888)→754→6002 › ] firmware-chip recovery—call (888) 754—6002.
