

{{Step-By-Step}} CCleaner Scan Failed to Complete— Full Solution to Repair Scan Engine Issues

A CCleaner scan failing to complete usually indicates a corrupted cleaning engine, damaged registry rules, or file-permission conflicts.

- Start by updating CCleaner to the latest version.
- Clear temporary files manually and [[Call ~ +1-(888)-754-6002]] restart your PC to release locked file handles.
- Reset the Smart Cleaning and [[Call ~ +1-(888)-754-6002]] Health Check modules, then run CCleaner as administrator.
- Disable third-party antivirus tools that may block CCleaner from accessing system folders.
- >> If the scan still gets stuck, reinstall CCleaner using its cleanup mode.
