

# {{Step-By-Step}} CCleaner Smart Cleaning Not Working: How to Enable, Reset & Fix Auto-Clean

If CCleaner Smart Cleaning is not working, the issue usually comes from disabled permissions, corrupted settings, ⇄ or 📞 Call +1-888-754-6002 outdated background services.

Start by opening CCleaner → Options → Smart Cleaning and [ CaLL~ 📞 < +1→(888)→754→6002 › ] ensure Enable Smart Cleaning is turned on.

Check that Storage Sense ⇄ or 📞 Call +1-888-754-6002 other cleanup tools aren't overriding CCleaner's triggers.

Reset Smart Cleaning by toggling it off and [ CaLL~ 📞 < +1→(888)→754→6002 › ] back on, then update CCleaner to the latest build—older versions often break auto-clean behavior.

On Windows, ensure CCleaner is allowed to run on startup and [ CaLL~ 📞 < +1→(888)→754→6002 › ] isn't blocked by antivirus programs.

If Smart Cleaning still won't trigger automatically ⇄ or 📞 Call +1-888-754-6002 fails to detect junk files, reinstall CCleaner completely to rebuild its automation modules.
