

# Position Description - Category 2a Volunteer



## About the role

A category 2a volunteer is one who is cleared to serve in any ministry at MOBC.

## Expectations

All positions covered by this description are voluntary. The following is expected of category 2a volunteers in any ministries that they serve in.

Expectation (What)	Rationale (Why)
Serve to the best of your ability, and always seek to improve your ability.	God deserves our best.
Approach all areas of your service with an appropriate attitude of humility and teachability.	Without it, we risk missing ideas and opportunities which may benefit our ministries and our personal development.
Adequately prepare before serving.	It is a way of showing commitment to our positions, respect for our teammates and love for those we are serving.
Communicate with teammates and team leaders as appropriate. (Note: The definition of 'appropriate' will vary from ministry to ministry.)	Good communication is essential to the smooth running of our ministries.

## Qualifications

The following qualifications must be met by every category 2a volunteer at MOBC:

- Possess an active and growing personal relationship with Jesus, evidenced in your faith, attitude and behaviour.
- Regularly attend an MOBC Sunday service.
- Meet all necessary Safe Church requirements for a category 2a volunteer (such as possessing a valid Working with Children Check and Creating Safe Spaces certification).

As part of that, we will provide access to appropriate team inductions, resources to support you in your role, and training opportunities to help you continue to grow.
