Act One

The Script

Act One

Song 1: *One Very Special Night*

Scene One:

A street in Jerusalem. Narrator stands stage left. The sign 'Jerusalem Palms Resort' stands stage right. A small booking desk, with a bell button, is under the sign.

Narrator: What you are about to see and hear is the story of Christmas.
The time... Christmas Eve.
The place ... Bethlehem – a small suburban town on the outskirts of Jerusalem. easily found in GoogleMaps.
Mary is soon going to have her baby, so they are in a bit of a hurry to find somewhere to stay for the night.

Enter Mary, Joseph and the donkey.

Mary: Hey, Joseph! We'd better find somewhere to stay – and pretty soon too.

Mary pats her 'big' tummy. Joseph wipes his furrowed brow.

Joseph: Phew! I'm doing my best, Mary. I shall try that inn over there.

Narrator: Joseph makes his way over to the door of the 'Jerusalem Palms Resort'. He knocks on the desk several times and after a long wait, is greeted by the innkeeper.

Barry enters and stands behind the desk.

Barry: Good evening, folks! Barry's the name! Sleep's the game! How can I help you?

Joseph: Mary is soon to have her baby, therefore, we need somewhere to stay.
