



## **Munich Brauhaus Sydney is back in business**

### **Raise a stein, enjoy the oompah band and indulge in a Bavarian feast**

**Tuesday, 9 November 2021:** Celebratory Oktoberfest-themed destination Munich Brauhaus is reopening its doors with an extra oompah oomph on Friday, 12 November at 12pm, as the hospitality fun returns to Sydney in time for summer and end of year group celebrations.

Located in the heart of The Rocks, the city's one and only traditional Bavarian bier hall will throw off the dust sheets after 19 months and bring back its unbridled, and unrivalled, Oktoberfest spirit.

Locals and visitors to The Rocks can enjoy the classic Bavarian dishes for which Munich Brauhaus is renowned, to the backdrop of a traditional oompah band, Friday to Sunday from midday.

Guests can dine indoors and soak up the Bavarian-themed ambience or enjoy summertime alfresco Bavarian dishes and brews in the spacious bier garden at the restaurant's entrance.

A flavour-packed, family-friendly menu returns with all the original favourites, including mighty pork knuckles that are thick with golden crackling, generous slabs of crisp pork belly, traditional German sausages, and a tasting platter brimful with classic dishes, all served with accompaniments such as sauerkraut, red cabbage and lashings of bier jus. Don't forget the schnitzels: golden-crumbed, plate-sized, and fantastically fulfilling.

A value-packed Best of Munich set menu takes the pain out of decision making with a tasting platter of haus favourites accompanied with fresh baked pretzels and indulgent apple strudel – the latter spiked with aromatic cinnamon and other spices. (\$49 per person, minimum two people.)

A children's menu is available, and a Kids Eat Free deal enables those under the age of 12 to eat for free when dining with an adult who purchases a main meal.

Raise a stein of German beer or clink glasses of speciality schnapps to celebrate the reopening, the return of the Bavarian festivities, and the restaurant's much-loved oompah band, which will play from 6pm to 10pm on Friday and Saturday and 12pm-2pm on Sundays. A generous happy hour welcomes diners back with \$6 house wine and spirits, \$8 500ml Aussie beers, and \$15 1-litre steins of Australian brews.

Dial up the end of year fun and host festive parties and celebrations across communal tables designed for groups, big biers and big feasts. Or make Munich Brauhaus Sydney the ultimate buck's party destination with a three-course share-style feast that includes two hours of beers, cocktails and wine for \$89 per person.

Munich Brauhaus is part of the Pacific Concepts casual hospitality group. Pacific Concepts Chief Executive Officer Thomas Pash said the return of Munich Brauhaus was a long-awaited reopening, which brought a flagship dining and entertainment destination back to the heart of The Rocks.

"We are thrilled to be reopening Sydney's legendary, one-and-only, traditional bier hall just in time for summer and end of year celebrations," Mr Pash said.

"We are looking forward to seeing local workers, visitors and tourists indulge in our Bavarian hospitality and enjoy the festive Oktoberfest atmosphere that is unique to Munich Brauhaus."
