Echuca Holiday Park Management and Staff would like to extend a warm welcome. We hope you enjoy your stay with us and if we can be of assistance please do not hesitate to contact our office. The following information and guidelines are provided to ensure visitors to our park have an enjoyable and safe stay.

1. Fees

Please ensure that all fees are paid in advance.

2. Check In-Out

Fees are calculated until 10.00am on the day of departure. If your travel arrangements are inconvenienced by these times please contact the Reception to make alternative arrangements. Site check in 11.00am and Cabin check in 2.00pm.

3. Bicycles, Scooters, Skateboards, Roller Skates and Roller Blades

Customers are more than welcome to ride bicycles, scooters and the like in the park, ensuring that a helmet is worn at all times, however so that everyone enjoys their holiday, we ask that parents remind their children that these are for use during DAYLIGHT HOURS ONLY and that they are not to be ridden around the amenities blocks, pool area or front of reception for the safety of all patrons. Please note: motorised scooters, mini bikes etc are not permitted to be used in the park grounds.

4. Noise

The peaceful enjoyment of our park and its facilities by all visitors is important to us. Please assist by being considerate to your neighbours and restrict noise from radios, televisions and social gatherings after 10pm and before 6am.

5. Children

The park and its facilities are provided for the enjoyment of you and your children. The supervision of your children is important for their safety and to ensure they do not disturb other people in the park. Children must be accompanied by an adult when visiting the showers and toilets.

6. Vehicles

The safety of our customers is of prime importance. You can assist our cause by limiting the speed of your vehicle to 5 kilometres (walking pace) whilst within the Park. Please ask your visitors to park their vehicles outside of the park, as only one vehicle per site is allowed.

7. Your Site

Please keep your site tidy and use the facilities provided for drying clothes, discharge of sullage water and rubbish disposal. Please do not dig trenches, or erect clothes lines on or around your site. Unfortunately no open fires are permitted under local law.

8. Pets

Unfortunately pets and caravan parks do not mix. Please make other arrangements for your pets prior to coming away on holidays.

9. Securing your Site

The Park Managers do their best to ensure a safe and secure environment, but we do recommend that visitors to the park take the precaution of securing items of value left outside their tent/caravan during the day and overnight.

10. Night Pans

We ask for the health and safety of all patrons, that you do not empty or rinse night pans down the sullage drains or in any sinks, please use the toilets or the Dump Point provided.

11. Swimming Pool

Solar & Electric Heated Pool Rules: No alcohol, no glass, no diving and Adult Supervision required for children under 12.
