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Palmer Street is located on the south bank of Ross River in the CBD and captures the essence of international cuisine and metropolitan accommodation. Palmer Street boasts award-winning restaurants for breakfast, lunch or dinner, and offers mouth-watering flavours guaranteed to tantalise your taste buds. Whether you fancy Indian, Asian, Italian, Greek, French, Mexican, modern Australian or locally-caught seafood, a visit to Townsville's premium eat street is a must. The central location offers proximity to public transport, the city's vibrant nightlife hub and gorgeous views across Ross Marina.



Flinders Street is the traditional city heart of Townsville and is home to a wide variety of retail shops and service providers. Flinders Street is also the venue for the award winning Cotters Market, held every Sunday. In Flinders Street you will discover Flinders Square, home of the Visitor Information Centre, various eateries and entertainment. The precinct boasts a dynamic, fresh and people-friendly atmosphere.

The Strand is one of Townsville's great cultural highlights. This spectacular waterfront promenade is perfect for families or for those wanting to soak up Townsville's laid back tropical atmosphere. This 2.2km, palm tree studded stretch is adorned with bike and walkway paths, safe swimming beaches, picturesque picnic spots, a water park and chic restaurants and bars with to-die-for water views. You can enjoy the free family fun of the water park, fish off the pier, dine at one of the many eateries or restaurants, or simply laze on the multi award-winning beach and enjoy the million dollar views to Magnetic Island.



Flinders Street East runs parallel to Palmer Street across the river and boasts an eclectic mix of restaurants, nightclubs, pubs and wine bars. The strip is not only the nightlife precinct of the city; it is an emerging hot spot for diners before meeting friends for an evening out on the town.



The Attractions at the end of Flinders Street East provide the whole family with the opportunity to get up close and personal with Townsville's indigenous culture, marine life and local history.
