SPEED LIMIT: Walking pace

POWERED SITES: Our generators are rotated according to load requirements. The change over of generators can mean that the power will be shut off for 3 minutes. The park is dimly lit for environmental and economical reasons, always use a torch. **No private generators.**

AVAILABLE AT STORE: Milk, bread, eggs, hot and cold drinks, ice creams, dry, canned and frozen foods, ice, fresh fruit and vegetables, bait, tackle, souvenirs, camping gear, bakery, pizza bar and take away foods available during April to October. Public phones are located at the shop.

RUBBISH DISPOSAL: Rubbish bin compounds are located at the ablution blocks. Please separate your bottles into the bin provided and return unwanted shells to the beach.

FISHERMEN: Do not leave offal or catfish on the beach, please dispose of it in the bins provided at the fish cleaning area. Information on size and bag limits is available at shop.

MOTORBIKE/ATV'S/4WD: The following regulations are conditions of your stay. This is the only warning you will receive.

- Minimal motorbike and vehicle movement within the caravan park.
- No motorbike or vehicle movement between 7pm and 7am unless departing.
- Markers have been placed above the high water mark 1km either side of the pedestrian beach access. Between these markers is a pedestrian zone.
- Persons under 17 years of age or unlicensed persons cannot be in control of any motorised transport within this pedestrian area or within the caravan park.
- The speed limit within the park is 5kph and the speed limit within the pedestrian zone on the beach is 15kph.
- Wallal Downs Station and the access roads are closed to the public.
- Bikes and vehicles must be kept at least 30 metres from the sand dunes. It is advisable not to take vehicles onto the beach during tides greater than 6.5m.
- The beach and car park are closed to all motorised transport between 7pm and 7am.
- Children riding bikes on the beach will need to be supervised by a licensed adult. The safety and behaviour of these children is the responsibility of the supervising adult. The supervisor of these children needs to be aware that on-road rules now apply off-road and that technically they are participating in an illegal activity. Eighty Mile Beach Caravan Park management and staff do not recommend, condone or take responsibility for any issues arising from such activity.
- The beach may soon be closed to all vehicles due to a few irresponsible people unable to follow a few simple common sense guidelines.

TELEVISION & RADIO: ABC1 2 3 24, TEN GWN, ELEVEN, ONE, 7MATE, GEM, WIN and 7TWO is transmitted. FM88.9 is the ABC radio.

CAR WASHING: Car wash facilities available in the public car park.

CAMPFIRES: Sorry no fires.

NOISE: Noise is to be kept minimal at all times. No noise after 10 p.m.

SWIMMING: There isn't a safe patrolled swimming area. We do not advise swimming.
