Visit the local Museum to learn more about Nyngan.

Located in the Railway Square.

Open Mon to Fri 9am - 4pm, Sat 10 - 12.30pm



On Display:

- Boards depicting our history since 1835 when Major Thomas Mitchell first ventured down the Bogan River
- Video and photographs from the Nyngan 1990 Flood.
- Audio room where older Nyngan residents' stories can be heard.
- Display of a 1800's kitchen from Gilgione Station.
- Scale model of the Girilambone Copper Company
- Replica Charcoal Safe
- Dolls and toys
- Wedding Cake over 100 years old (kept in a glass case)
- Sewing machines
- Microfilm reader - with micro film of the Nyngan Newspapers from 1898 to 1996.
- A railway display showing the important role the railway played in the history of Nyngan - railway switchboard, several pieces of luggage, porter's bicycle and railway lanterns.
- Switchboard from the local telephone exchange - 1 of 5 that made up the Switchboard Information Service of the Post Office from 1854 to 1975.
- 1914 - 1918 Honour Board
- Barber Shop
