FITZGERALD RIVER NATIONAL PARK

One of the largest and most botanically significant national parks in Australia. Within the park are found nearly 20 per cent of WA's flora species, many of which occur only within its boundaries.

The park features a tantalising variety of landscapes to explore from rolling plains, colourful breakaways, rugged peaks and headlands to stunning bays and inlets.
