## DRAFT ALERT – FIRES IN SPRAY BOOTHS UPDATE

The CRA would like to advise that in October of 2007 we issued a draft alert to all CRA members, which was condensed from a draft alert issued by the NZ Department of Labour.

In the process of simplifying the document, we erroneously identified Monarch Industries specifically. The CRA would like to formally apologise to Monarch Industries for this error.

However, the CRA would like to reiterate the following:

- Annual maintenance of burners and heat exchangers (where fitted) must be undertaken to ensure that deterioration does not occur.
- Maintenance should be undertaken by 'competent persons' who are authorised by the booth manufacturer or can demonstrate significant experience and knowledge so as to be deemed 'competent'.

Finally, the CRA wish to restate that the draft alert as issued in October of 2007 erroneously identified Monarch Industries specifically and we would like to extend our sincerest apologies.
