## FEATURES:

- Silver grey foliage year round.
- Foliage releases aromatic scent when crushed.
- Neat, dense habit which responds well to clipping for hedging or topiary specimens.
- Grows well in containers.
- Fast and easy to grow.
- Dry tolerant once established.



## SUGGESTED USES:

- Dry or gravel gardens.
- Low hedging/edging.
- Small gardens/spaces.
- General garden use.
- Mass plant for low maintenance areas.



## CULTURAL CARE

Select a sunny location in most soil types that are well draining. Once established watering requirements are low requiring only occasional long soak during extended periods of heat. Prune to shape in early spring and apply slow release fertiliser. Trim lightly but more frequently for hedging.



A popular selection due to its splendid silvery foliage and naturally neat habit. The neutral tones also make it a popular choice for mixed borders where it complements the colourful blooms of perennials and breaks the continuous green of many shrubby borders. Often included in herb gardens as the small yellow flowers produced if left untrimmed attract pollinators whilst the foliage releases an curry-like scent if crushed or brushed against. For a delightful celebration of foliage in a landscape, combine with the likes of *Euphorbia* 'Ascot Rainbow' and *E. 'Craigieburn'*, *Loropetalum* 'Plum Gorgeous' or *Abelia* 'Kaleidoscope'.
