

Eucomis comosa 'Sparkling Burgundy'

FEATURES:

- Striking sword-like foliage emerges as a deep burgundy providing a colourful foil for pink flower spikes produced during summer.
- Commonly known as 'pineapple lily' due to flower spikes being crowned by a central rosette of foliage.
- Hardy and easy to grow tolerating dry conditions.
- Easy and fast growing for quick results.

SUGGESTED USES:

- Water wise for containers or gardens.
- Small or narrow spaces in gardens/ courtyards.
- Last well as a cut flower for floral arrangements.
- Year round interest for general garden use.

CULTURAL CARE

Grows well in most soils which are well draining. Once established water requirements are low but do not allow to dry out over extended periods of heat. Generally no pruning required other than removal of spent flower stems to encourage further flushes.

In cold climates foliage will recede during winter with fresh, colourful new growth reappearing in spring. Apply a slow release fertiliser during spring for best results.
