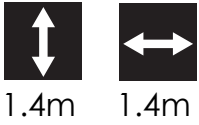


Salvia mexicana

FOR

Bright flowering display and lush looking foliage for mixed garden plantings.

Fast growing for water wise and low maintenance landscapes.

Ideal filler or for adding height in mixed cottage/wildflower style gardens.

Attracts birds and other pollinators.

CARE

Dry tolerant. Water when dry for first 6 weeks after planting.

Apply mulch to help retain moisture during warmer months.

Prune back hard late winter to encourage a dense, bushy habit.

Apply a slow release fertiliser during spring.

If frost in frost prone areas - plant under trees or next to buildings for protection.

- any frost damage can be removed and plant will recover.
