



CREATIVE COMMONS LICENCES



Attribution - allows for the replication, distribution, display, performance and remixing of copyrighted work provided that the author is credited.



Attribution / non-commercial - allows the replication, distribution, display, performance and mixing of copyrighted work provided that the author is credited and re-use of the material is restricted to non-commercial purposes only.



Attribution / share alike - allows the replication, distribution, display, performance and remixing of copyrighted work provided that the author is credited and that the new works based upon the material are licensed under identical conditions.



Attribution / no derivative - allows the replication, distribution, display and performance of copyrighted work – provided that the author is credited and that no derivative works are created from the original material.



Attribution / non-commercial / share alike - allows replication, distribution, display and performance of copyrighted work provided that the author is credited and reuse of the material is restricted to non-commercial purposes only, and that any derivative works are licensed under identical conditions.



Attribution / non-commercial / no derivative - allows the replication, distribution, display and performance of copyrighted work provided that the author is credited and reuse of the material is restricted to non-commercial purposes only and that no derivative works are created from the original material.



Restrictive licence - used for material that may contain personal or other confidential information as well as material to be licensed under some form of limiting or restrictive condition. For example, a time limit on use or payment arrangements other than an initial once-only fee.
