

**MENTAL HEALTH ACT 2009**

**INSTRUMENT OF AUTHORISATION**

**Pursuant to section 29(4)**

**AUTHORISATION BY THE DIRECTOR OF AN APPROVED TREATMENT CENTRE TO EMPLOYEES**

**WHEREAS** pursuant to section 29(4) of the *Mental Health Act 2009* (the Act) the director of an approved treatment centre (ATC) or an employee in an ATC authorised by the director of the centre for the purpose may make an application to the Guardianship Board (the Board) established under the *Guardianship and Administration Act 1993* for the Board to make a level 3 inpatient treatment order in respect of a person

**AND**

**WHEREAS** the ADELAIDE CLINIC is an ATC pursuant to a determination made by the Minister dated 30 June 2010 under section 96 of the Act

I, CAROL TURNBULL..... being for the time being in charge of the ATC and Director of the ATC for the purposes of the administration of the Act

**HEREBY AUTHORISE** pursuant to section 29(4) of the Act,


- any person from time to time holding or acting in the position of consultant psychiatrist with lead clinical responsibility for mental health services within the ATC and
- any medical practitioner, other than an intern, working within the ATC who liaises with or is accountable to the consultant psychiatrist with lead clinical responsibility for mental health services within the ATC

**TO** make an application for the Board to make a level 3 inpatient treatment order in respect of a person.

This authorisation will take effect immediately.

This authorisation does not limit the ability of the Director to carry out these responsibilities personally at any time.

This authorisation may be revoked at any time.
