

Parties and Signatories to a CALHN Research Agreement

It is imperative that the parties to a research agreement are properly identified to ensure that the correct legal entities are bound by the contract.

Please Note: Central Adelaide Local Health Network Incorporated (ABN 96 269 526 412) is the legal entity for all CALHN agreements.

This includes agreements for the Royal Adelaide Hospital, The Queen Elizabeth Hospital and SA Pathology which are not separate legal entities and therefore cannot enter into a legally binding contract.

Please Note: Any wording which follows after Central Adelaide Local Health Network Incorporated (ABN 96 269 526 412) (e.g. Royal Adelaide Hospital or SA Pathology) is descriptive only, and intended to assist the parties in identifying the relevant organisation, within CALHN, that is involved in the contract.

1) CALHN Business Title and Address

2) Other Party

The other party to the contract may be a Sponsor, a CRO acting as a Local Sponsor, or a Collaborative or Cooperative Research Group (CRG). These parties may be various types of legal entities (eg proprietary company, company limited by guarantee, not-for-profit incorporated association, university or statutory body).

It is very important to independently verify the correct name and type of entity with whom CALHN is contracting, usually by doing an ASIC company search or other searches.

3) Signatories

A CALHN agreement must be signed by an authorised officer on behalf of their organisation e.g. Chief Executive Officer/Chief Operating Officer/ Executive Director Medical Services/ or delegate.

Please Note: Principal Investigators and Clinical Trial Coordinators do not have the legal authority to sign agreements on behalf of CALHN.

The Principal Investigator, though named in Schedule 1 to the Medicines Australia Agreements, is not a party to the CTRA. However, the Principal Investigator must sign to acknowledge the obligations the Agreement imposes.
