Healthcare Worker (HCW) information

Exposure to a COVID-19 positive patient or HCW

Healthcare Workers (HCW) that have been identified by the CDCB/ CALHN CWHS/PCU as having contact with a positive patient or healthcare worker will be notified to not attend work and to self-isolate

Please ensure your area lead has emailed your details (name, position, program and contact phone number), complete the [self-isolation reporting form](#) and lodge a SLS.

Isolation is to occur at home or in alternate accommodation provided for the designated isolation period by CDCB.

HCW in isolation are to monitor symptoms for fever, respiratory symptoms or any change in general health condition. If a HCW becomes symptomatic they are to notify the CDCB (1300 232 272) and arrange for testing.

Release from isolation: please contact CALHN Clinical Worker Health Service on the day before your isolation release date to discuss and confirm you have clearance to return to work
