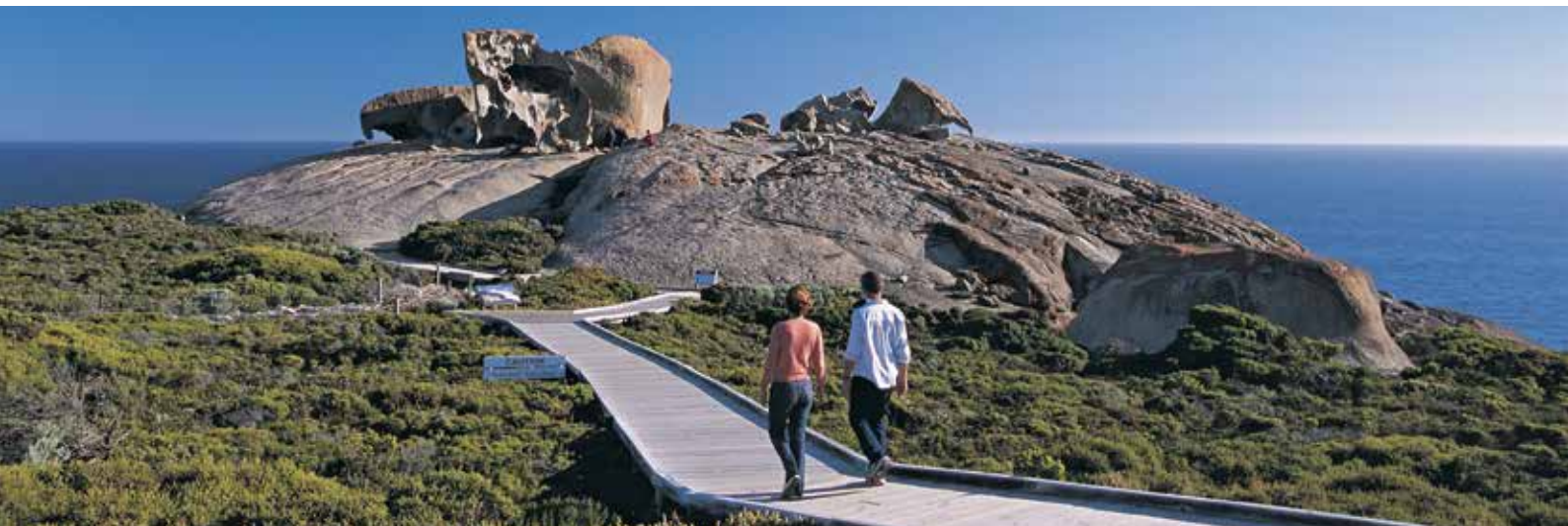


Self-Drive Itinerary



THREE DAY SIGHTS & SOUNDS OF KANGAROO ISLAND

To truly understand the lure of Kangaroo Island, it must be experienced, and the only way to do that is to allow yourself extra time to slow down and take pleasure in all of the popular sights and sounds of the island.

- Explore the pretty coastal town of Penneshaw, with spectacular views of the South Australian mainland.
- Join a guided tour of South Australia's first lighthouse, rich in maritime history, at Cape Willoughby Conservation Park.
- Enjoy the stunning views of Eastern Cove and the amazing food at Sunset Food & Wine, while dining from either the a la carte or degustation menu (closed May to September - check opening hours on their website before visiting).
- Discover the quiet, friendly fishing village of American River nestled on a hillside of native bushland.
- Discover the local successful honey industry – see the bees, learn about the extraction process and taste the honey flavours produced at Clifford's Honey Farm or Island Beehive.
- Walk around the Nursery while you wait for your gourmet pizza made with fresh produce from their garden at Frogs & Roses Garden Centre.
- Visit Islander Estate Vineyard's Tasting Room at Cygnet River and discover why these European style wines are so popular.
- Explore Kingscote, the commercial hub and largest town on Kangaroo Island. With a population just over 2000, it was originally known as Queenscliffe and is a short distance south from Reeves Point.
- Taste the award winning wines and enjoy the nautical delights at Bay of Shoals Winery, located just north of Kingscote, overlooking the Bay of Shoals and Reeves Point.
- Stroll along the beach with your guide through a wild seal colony at Seal Bay Conservation Park, home to around 1000 of the rare Australian sea lions.
- Hire a sandboard or toboggan and experience the thrills and spills of sandboarding down the spectacular white sand dunes of Little Sahara.
- Take a picnic or go beachcombing along the long, curved, sandy beach at Vivonne Bay.
- Marvel at Remarkable Rocks, a grouping of majestic granite boulders carved by nature, standing as sentinels over the Southern Ocean.
- Watch the fierce ocean swells at Admirals Arch, a natural archway framing Long-nosed Fur Seals basking on the rocky shoreline.
- Experience the wildlife up close and personal at Hanson Bay Wildlife Sanctuary where you can take a guided nocturnal tour or stroll down Koala Walk – Koalas guaranteed!
- Visit the Kangaroo Island Wildlife Park just out of Parndana and see a large range of Australian native animals. Handfeed Kangaroos and Wallabies, get up close to Koalas and enter the Reptile house if you dare!
- Feast on a delicious seafood platter and enjoy the absolute water frontage, cliff-top views at Penny's Restaurant in Penneshaw.
