


2 Day Kangaroo Island Adventure Tour



Day 1 – Highlights include:

1. ROB'S SHEARING

A truly authentic Australian experience! Watch Rob, a real Aussie character and his dogs skilfully muster and yard sheep, learn about farm life and see a sheep shearing demonstration as you discover the techniques involved in this highly skilled task.

2. EMU RIDGE EUCALYPTUS DISTILLERY & LUNCH

Eucalyptus Oil is produced naturally from the Kangaroo Island Narrow-Leaf Mallee which is the dense multi-stemmed tree growing at the sides of the road. Eucalyptus oil has many uses, disinfectant, insect repellent, soothes bites and stings, decongestant, stain remover and cleaner. Visit the shop and see the many products using eucalyptus oil, which are available for purchase. Enjoy a freshly prepared lunch.

3. SEAL BAY

Seal Bay is the home of the Australian sea lion and the third largest breeding colony in Australia. You will have the opportunity to see these creatures close-up, swimming in the surf or basking in the sand. Seal Bay is a conservation park and you will be taken down onto the beach by a Parks Interpretative Office. Take your camera with you, as this is a unique opportunity to walk on the beach with these animals.

4. LITTLE SAHARA

This is an area of spectacular white sand dunes, surrounded by bush vegetation. Climbing over the first ridge you are confronted by a second much higher dune which, when scaled, does not reveal the coast as one would expect, but more dunes flanked by bushland. Here you can test your skills at sand boarding (Optional).

5. PENNESHAW – OVERNIGHT

Penneshaw is a pretty coastal village with spectacular views of the South Australian Mainland. Dinner at Sorrento's Pizzeria included. Free time to enjoy some of these suggested activities:

- Hog Bay Beach – swim, stroll or just enjoy the spectacular views
- Kangaroo Island Sculpture Walk through native bushland
- Penneshaw Hotel – pop in for a drink with the locals
- Penneshaw Penguin Centre

Day 2 – Highlights include:

1. KANGAROO ISLAND WILDLIFE PARK

With flames on their doorstep and an entire town evacuated, Sam Mitchell and some close family friends stayed and protected over 700 animals in their care. With over 150,000 hectares lost due to the fires, a large number of Koalas are being cared for here as they recover. The Kangaroo Island Wildlife Park will also provide you with the opportunity to walk amongst kangaroos and wallabies and you can hand feed them.

2. RAPTOR DOMAIN – BIRDS OF PREY

An awe-inspiring In-Flight Display of Australian Birds of Prey, Wedge Tailed Eagles, Kookaburras, Osprey, Sea Eagles, Australian Kestrels, Australian Hobby Falcons and different varieties of owls. Join Dave and Leeza Irwin and their wonderful presenters for an amazing interactive experience while the birds demonstrate their natural skills, adaptations and hunting techniques.

3. EMU BAY LAVENDER FARM AND LUNCH

This beautifully presented farm showcases a range of lavender varieties in terraced rows. Walk around the garden and visit the charming gift shop which sells lavender essential oils, scented candles and other Kangaroo Island products. Afterwards enjoy a freshly prepared lunch.

4. PENNINGTON BAY

Enjoy the panoramic view at Pennington Bay, a popular surfing and fishing beach.

5. PROSPECT HILL

512 steps take you to the top of the highest point on Kangaroo Island, Prospect Hill. With its rewarding views you can see Mount Lofty in the Adelaide Hills on a clear day, or to the south you will see the stretch of the south coast and Pennington Bay.
