


# 1 Day Kangaroo Island Sip and See Tour



## Highlights include:

### 1. Raptor Domain ('In-Flight' Birds of Prey Display)

Raptor Domain delivers the only 'In-Flight' Birds of Prey Display in South Australia. Meet an array of birds including Jedda the majestic Wedge-tailed Eagle. Enjoy a delightful interactive experience with Casper the friendly Barn Owl, Banjo and Clancy the laughing Kookaburras and many more. This display is thought of by many to be the most interactive and educational Birds of Prey display they have seen.

### 2. Emu Ridge Eucalyptus Distillery (lunch, shop visit and guided tour)

Eucalyptus Oil is produced naturally from the Kangaroo Island Narrow-Leaf Mallee which is the dense multi-stemmed tree growing at the sides of the road. Eucalyptus oil has many uses, disinfectant, insect repellent, soothes bites and stings, decongestant, stain remover and cleaner. The traditional distilling processes to extract the eucalyptus oil from the leaves will be explained and you will be taken on a guided tour of the distillery. Visit the shop and see the many products using eucalyptus oil, which are available for purchase. Enjoy a freshly prepared Aussie barbecue lunch, cake, tea and coffee. Kangaroo Island Ciders' range of Colony Cove products including Apple Sparkler, Draught Cider and Original Cider are available for tasting (additional cost).

### 3. Clifford's Honey Farm (guided tour and shop visit)

Kangaroo Island is the only place in the world with a pure strain of the Ligurian bee. Here, you'll be taken on a guided tour of the honey room where you will learn about the extraction process, taste a honey soft drink and have the option to sample the Drunken Drone Brewery's Honey Wheat Ale. In the farm gate shop, you can see a working beehive where you can try to spot the Queen bee. There are different varieties of pure Kangaroo Island Ligurian honey and beauty products to purchase as well as their famous honey ice-cream.

### 4. Pennington Bay (photo opportunity)

Enjoy the panoramic view at Pennington Bay, the narrowest part of the Island. The Southern Ocean beach is a popular surfing and fishing spot, and you may see some dolphins whilst you are there.

### 5. False Cape Wines (wine tasting)

False Cape Wines' Cellar Door, surrounded by picturesque vineyards, is made from recycled wood, jetty timbers and limestone sourced on the property. The Cellar Door allows visitors to taste False Cape Wines in an idyllic setting nestled among the vineyard and gum trees. Here you can take part in a structured wine tasting while enjoying the peaceful views.
