ONE DAY TASTE OF KANGAROO ISLAND – KINGSCOTE

Head inland and discover some of the hidden treasures in the Kingscote and Emu Bay Regions. From wine cellars to honey farms, the taste buds will be working overtime as you experience what the island has to offer.

- Discover the local successful honey industry – see the bees, learn about the extraction process and taste the honey flavours produced at Clifford's Honey Farm or Island Beehive
- Take a guided tour at Emu Ridge Eucalyptus Distillery, the only commercial distillery still in operation in South Australia, and afterwards enjoy lunch from the cafe on the deck
- Walk along the pristine, 4 kilometre sandy beach at Emu Bay, a favourite spot for playful dolphins - or you may prefer to drive along the only beach on Kangaroo Island with vehicle access
- Walk around the terraced garden at Emu Bay Lavender Farm, and relax with a cup of tea or coffee and a lavender biscuit in the cafe
- Visit the first official settlement in South Australia, Reeves Point, and see the Old Mulberry Tree brought from England in 1836 by the original settlers, and still bearing fruit in season
- Explore Kingscote, the commercial hub and largest town on Kangaroo Island. With a population just over 2000, it was originally known as Queenscliffe and is a short distance south from Reeves Point
- See the diverse display of artworks at KI Gallery, produced entirely by local artists, including jewellery, ceramics, glasswork, photography, woodcraft, painting and sculpture.
- Drop into Amadio Wines' cellar door located in the centre of Kingscote, where you can find award-winning Kangaroo Island wines and rustic tapas - style platters
- Visit the Hope Cottage Museum, a beautifully maintained National Trust museum. This former cottage was built in 1859 and is decked out in period style, with a tiny walled rose garden
- Enjoy cooked or fresh KI seafood packs at Kangaroo Island Fresh Seafoods
- Taste the award winning wines and enjoy the nautical delights at Bay of Shoals Winery, located just north of Kingscote, overlooking the Bay of Shoals and Reeves Point
- Take a break at KI Brewery, the island's original micro brewery. There you can sample and purchase a range of craft beer, and grab something to eat while enjoying the great ambience and beautiful views
