

1. Where does the Plan apply?

This plan applies to all land in Sutherland Shire to which the following plans apply:

- (a) Sutherland Shire Local Environmental Plan 2000,
- (b) Sutherland Shire Local Environmental Plan Menai Town Centre 1992.
- (c) Sydney Regional Environmental Plan No.17 Kurnell Peninsula (1989).

2. What is the purpose of the Plan?

The purpose of this plan is to reduce the time period for lapsing of development consents from five years to three years.

3. What are the overall objectives?

The objectives of reducing the duration of the time period for the lapsing of development consents are:

- * Achieve greater certainty in the development process;
- * Quantify and comprehend the cumulative impacts of a development easier;
- * Reduce the likelihood in a change in ownership of neighbouring properties to the site subject to the development consent; and
- * Reduce the occurrence of dormant sites around the Shire.

4. The duration of development consent

In accordance with the provisions of Section 95 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act, 1979, all development consents shall lapse three years after the date from which it operates.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 95A of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act, 1979, Council may consent to an extension of the period of consent, for a period of one year, subject to receipt of an application in writing seeking such an extension within one month of the date of the consent lapsing.

In any application for a one year extension, Council will consider if planning controls have significantly changed in the interim and/or the characteristics of the local area have changed since consent was issued.
