Non-residential Contribution Rates (JUNE QUARTER 2016)

Development type	Contribution rate
Non residential that results in an increase gross floor area in Hurstville City Centre (for public domain works)	\$158.29 per m ² of gross floor area
Non residential development that does not meet all of its parking requirements through onsite parking provision in:	
- Hurstville City Centre	\$52,491.81 per deficient parking space
- Penshurst, Mortdale, Beverly Hills and Riverwood commercial centres	\$30,517.38 per deficient parking space

Notes:

1. The contribution rates for the June Quarter 2016 became effective on 27 July 2016 and will remain effective until Council's system is updated with the September Quarter 2016 CPI (the ABS release date for the September Quarter 2016 CPI is 26 October 2016).
2. The June Quarter 2016 CPI figure is: 109.3
3. The Hurstville Section 94 Development Contributions Plan 2012 (clauses 2.12 and 2.13) and conditions of the Development Consent provide for the adjustment/indexation of section 94 contributions. The contributions are adjusted at the time of payment to reflect changes in the Consumer Price Index (All Groups Index) for Sydney.
