

## Terms and conditions for Shout Hashtag Competition 2016-04

1. Information on how to enter and prizes forms part of these conditions of entry. Entry into the Shout Hashtag Competition 2016-04 (“Competition”) constitutes acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.
2. The promoter is Shout For Good Pty Ltd (“Shout”), ABN 45 163 218 639 of Level 13, 55 Collins Street, Melbourne, VIC, 3000 Australia.
3. Entry is only open to Australian residents. Employees of Shout For Good Pty Ltd, Australia and New Zealand Banking Group Limited (and their immediate families) and its subsidiaries and related entities are not eligible to enter (“Eligible Entrant”).
4. The Promotion commences on Friday April 15 2016 at 12:00 am AEST and closes on Friday April 29 2016 at 12:00am AEST (“Promotional Period”).
5. To enter the promotion, Eligible Entrant must, within the Promotional Period:
  - i. Register their details
  - ii. Provide valid contact details to be contacted if Eligible Entrant has won a prize.
  - iii. Complete the survey
  - iv. Create a hashtag using “Shout” with an explanation or example
  - v. Receive a confirmation (Thank You page) that the Eligible Entrant has been accepted for participation in the competition.
  - vi. The Eligible Entrant is confirming his or her willingness to participate in the Competition by completing the online survey. (Clicking “Done”)
6. There is a limit of one entry per entrant. Multiple entries will result in ineligibility.
7. The winners will be selected on Monday May 2 2016 by Shout at Level 13, 55 Collins Street, Melbourne, VIC, 3000, Australia.
8. Shout will notify winners via email and phone by Friday May 6 2016 12:00 am AEST. The winners will also be published through Shout’s chosen social media channels.
9. The total maximum retail prize bank value is \$500 (excluding GST).
10. There will be three (3) prize winners based on best answer for most creative hashtag using “Shout”, judged by Shout:
  - i. The first Eligible Entry prize winner will receive AU \$300.00 subject to nomination in item (11.)
  - ii. The second Eligible Entry prize winner will receive AU \$150.00 subject to nomination in item (11.)
  - iii. The third Eligible Entry prize winner will receive AU \$50.00 subject to nomination in item (11.)
11. Eligible Entry prize winners must claim the FULL prize amount by nominating ONE of these methods:
  - i. Receive the FULL prize amount in cash via Visa Prepaid Gift Card or an equivalent prepaid gift card, subject to a valid Australian postal address.
  - ii. Donating the Full prize amount to a charity listed on the Shout platform chosen by the Eligible Entry Winner.

12. Eligible Entry Winners will not be allowed to change the method chosen in item (11.) once it has been nominated unless an exception is granted by Shout.
13. If (11)(i.) is nominated, the Eligible Entry Winner's prize will be mailed via Australia Post Registered Post or equivalent, to the winner's nominated address within 10 days of the winners being notified, subject to the winner confirming with Shout via email or phone, correct details to enable the prize to be delivered. In the event of an Eligible Entry Winner not being able to provide a valid Australian address, Shout reserves the right to deem the entry ineligible.
14. If (11)(ii.) is nominated, the Eligible Entry Winner's prize will be donated to the winner's nominated charity within 31 days of the winners being notified, subject to the winner confirming with Shout via email or phone, correct details to enable the prize to be donated. This transaction will be administered by Shout on behalf of the Eligible Entry Winner through methods Shout deems as appropriate. The nominated charity will receive the full prize amount and will not be subjected to any donation administration or transaction fees. The Eligible Entry Winner will be notified of their donation via email after the transaction has been completed.
15. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into, including in the event of a dispute. The prize is not exchangeable, transferable and non-cash prizes are not redeemable for cash.
16. Tax implications may arise from the prize winnings. Independent advice should be sought.
17. Shout reserves the right to re-judge in the event of an entrant being unable to satisfy these competition conditions or forfeiting or not claiming a prize. For any prize that remains unclaimed or forfeited through ineligibility or otherwise by Monday Aug 1 2016, Shout will award the prize to the entry deemed to be the next best entry. The winner will be notified via email and phone immediately.
