

# BEER LINE CLEANER

**HAZARDOUS  
LIQUID**

## PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

A heavy duty liquid containing alkaline builders, chelates and sequesterants particularly suited to the removal of scale from beer lines and pipes.

## USAGE DIRECTIONS

Use on a weekly basis, or according to individual brewery instructions.

1. Ensure compressor is turned off and control valves left open.
2. Flush beer lines with water, then clear with CO<sub>2</sub> gas.
3. Beer Line Cleaner should be diluted with cold water.
4. Add 60ml of Beer Line Cleaner to 5L of water (add 90ml Beer Line Cleaner if lines have been neglected).
5. Using CO<sub>2</sub> gas, force cleaning solution through beer lines.
6. To ensure that the lines are completely full, allow cleaning solution to flow freely from the taps before shutting off (visible as a pale blue coloured solution).
7. Leave for at least 30 minutes.
8. To ensure all lines are cleared of detergent, flush lines thoroughly with a minimum of 30 litres of water through each tap.

## STORAGE

- Store locked up in corrosion resistant container.

## DISPOSAL

- Dispose of contents/container in accordance with local/regional/national/international regulations.

- Rinse mouth.
- Wash contaminated clothing before reuse.
- Absorb spillage to prevent material damage.
