

# DESCALER

## PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Phosphoric acid based descaler for removing lime and scale deposits in automatic dishwashers.

## USAGE DIRECTIONS

Avoid contact with Skin and Eyes. Consult SDS before opening container. Use direct from container. Apply to scaled surfaces and allow to act. Where scale is inaccessible, apply product where possible then run machine through a normal cycle. Repeat treatment as needed. Always run a complete wash cycle after use of Descaler.

## CONTAINS

- Phosphoric acid **15-30%**

## STORAGE

- Store locked up
