Germex is a perfumed neutral detergent that will clean and deodorise surfaces in bathroom and toilet areas. A non acid cleaner for toilet bowls, vanities, showers, baths, floor tiles and other surfaces in the bathroom. Germex is Red in colour.

### PREPARATION

For Spray, add two (2) pumps of concentrate per 750ml of water.

### USE DIRECTIONS

Apply Spray Solution to soiled surfaces. Allow a few seconds for the solution to chemically soften soils. For stubborn soils, use a brush or pad to loosen. Rinse with clean water.

### DISPOSAL

Dispose of contents/container in accordance with local/regional/national/international regulations.

### CONTAINS

Polyoxyethylene C12C14 acid methyl ester 30-60%, Cocoamide MEA <10%, Alanine, N,N-bis(carboxymethyl)-, trisodium salt <5%, Didecyl Dimethylammonium Chloride <5%, Odour Masking Agent <5%, Lemon Perfume <5%, Water
