Genesis 2:4-25

**“God The Creator!”**

1. What do we learn of God in Genesis 1 and 2?
2. What was there in the beginning?
3. What was created on each of the six days of creation? What did God think of His creation?
4. What views do people hold of how the world came to be here? If someone said the world came about as a result of a “big bang” or it just happened, what would be your response?
5. What do we learn of man in these chapters? Who are you? Why are you here? What does it mean to be made in the image of God?
6. What tasks was man given? One task was to work in the garden? What attitude should we have towards work? (Colossians 3:22-25; II Thessalonians 3:6-10)
7. If we are stewards of where God has granted us to live what response as Christians do we give toward Climate Change; Coal Seam Gas; Genetically Modified Food; or simply keeping the environment clean?
8. What conditions were given for Adam and Eve to live in the garden? What would happen if they failed to comply with the conditions?
9. What was not good in the garden? How did God remedy what was not good?
10. What is God’s view of marriage? How does Genesis Two back up that view?
11. If someone said they wanted equality in marriage meaning they wanted same gender marriage what would you answer?
12. What response should you make toward the Creator God who has given us a place to live with Him? What did God make us for?
