9. If God is in control of the weather what does man think he can do to control it?
10. Why do you think some tribes willingly got involved in the battle? Why do you think some Christians willingly get involved in helping and encouraging Christian brothers and sisters?
11. Some tribes were reluctant. Why was this? What reasons do Christians put forward for avoiding involvement?
12. What is Deborah's prayer for God's people in verse 31? How can we grow stronger as Christians?
