7. What is the stall? Who will leap like calves? Why are they leaping?
8. What are the people asked to remember? Why?
9. What is the day of the LORD that is coming? How is this day described and why?
10. Who is the Elijah that is to come? Is it the one the gospel writers refer to? (Luke 1:17; Matthew 11:7-15; 17:10-13)
11. What is the impact of Elijah's preaching? How can fathers and children be turned away from each other?
12. In studying Malachi what have you learnt of God or yourself?
