4. How did Jesus respond to the Pharisee's accusations?
5. What did David do? Why was he not accused of acting unlawful?
6. Why were the priests working in the temple not accused of breaking the Sabbath Commandment?
7. Why would or should the Pharisees believe Jesus when He claims to be the one greater?
8. What did Jesus want to see in His people? How were they not showing this? How can we show this?
9. How is Jesus Lord of the Sabbath? What are the implications of His lordship for the Pharisees and for us?
10. What can or cannot be done on the Sabbath? What laws had the Pharisees put in place regarding the 4th Commandment?
11. Did the Pharisees think more of animals than they did of human life? Discuss.
12. How can or should we remember the Sabbath today?
