## Long Jacket

To fit: Medium - Large

### MATERIALS AND MEASUREMENTS

<b>Finished Bust</b>	120 47	cm ins
<b>Length to Shoulder</b>	100 39 ¼	cm ins
<b>Sleeve Length to underarm</b>	58 22 ¾	cm ins
<b>Sport Wool (100gr)</b>	13	Balls
<b>Needle sizes</b>	5mm knitting needles	

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#### ABBREVIATIONS

**approx** – approximately

**cm** – centimetre

**mm** – millimetre

**meas** – measures

**sts** – stitches

#### IMPORTANT

Use **ONLY** the Nako yarn specified. (We cannot accept responsibility for an imperfect garment if any other brand is used.) Follow our instructions exactly. We advise every knitter to check their tension carefully before commencing the garment.

#### TENSION

9 stitches over Brioche Stitch on 5mm needles – 10cm/4ins

#### BRIOCHE STITCH PATTERN

(over uneven number of sts)

**Row 1 (RS)** – Slip 1 knitwise with yarn at back; \*sl 1-yo (= bring working yarn to front between needles, slip 1 stitch purlwise, bring working yarn over top of needle to the back, which creates a yarn-over that crosses over the slipped stitch and the slipped stitch plus the yarn-over count as one stitch), k1; rep from \* to end.

**Row 2 (WS)** - Slip 1 knitwise with yarn at back; \*knit the slipped stitch and its yarn over together, sl 1-yo; rep from \* to last 2 sts; knit the slipped stitch and its yarn over together, k1.

**Row 3 (RS)** - Slip 1 knitwise with yarn at back, sl 1-yo; \*knit the slipped stitch and its yarn over together, sl 1-yo; rep from \* to last 2 sts; sl 1-yo, k1.

Rep rows 2 & 3 for Brioche pattern throughout.

## **BACK**

With 5mm needles, cast on 55 sts.  
Work in Brioché Stitch patt until piece meas 71cm/28ins from beg, end with a WS row.

### **Shape Armholes**

Keeping Brioché patt correct, cast off 3 sts beg next 4 rows, then 2 sts beg next following 2 rows, then dec 1 st beg next 2 following rows – 37 sts.

Pattern straight until piece meas 91cm/35 ¾ins from beg, end with a WS row.

### **Shape Shoulders**

Keeping Brioché patt correct, cast off loosely 6 sts beg next 4 rows – 13 sts. Cast off loosely rem 13 sts for back neck.

## **LEFT FRONT**

With 5mm needles, cast on 29 sts.  
Work in Brioché Stitch patt until piece meas 71cm/28ins from beg, end with a WS row.

### **Shape Armhole**

Keeping Brioché patt correct, cast off 3 sts beg next 2 RS rows, then 2 sts beg following RS row, then dec 1 st beg following RS row – 20 sts.

Patt straight until Front meas 24 rows less than Back to beg of shoulder shaping (when counting the 20 rows, remember that every “knit” stitch you see is actually 2 rows), end with a WS row.

### **Shape Neck**

Dec 1 st at neck edge next 8 RS rows – 12 sts.

Patt straight until front meas 91cm/35 ¾ins from beg, end with a WS row.

### **Shape Shoulder**

Keeping patt correct, cast off loosely 6 sts beg next 2 RS rows.

## **RIGHT FRONT**

With 5mm needles, cast on 29 sts.  
Work in Brioché Stitch patt until piece meas 71cm/28ins from beg, end with a RS row.

## **Shape Armhole**

Keeping Brioché patt correct, cast off 3 sts beg next 2 WS rows, then 2 sts beg following WS row, then dec 1 st beg following WS row – 20 sts.

Patt straight until Front meas 24 rows less than Back to beg of shoulder shaping (when counting the 20 rows, remember that every “knit” stitch you see is actually 2 rows), end with a WS row.

### **Shape Neck**

Dec 1 st at neck edge next 8 RS rows – 12 sts.

Patt straight until front meas 91cm/35 ¾ins from beg, end with a RS row.

### **Shape Shoulder**

Keeping patt correct, cast off loosely 6 sts beg next 2 WS rows.

## **SLEEVES**

With 5mm needles, cast on 21 sts.  
Work in Brioché Stitch patt and inc 1 st each end every 6th row 9 times – 39 sts.

Patt straight until sleeve meas 58cm/22 ¾ins from beg, end with a WS row.

### **Shape Top**

Cast off 3 sts beg next 4 rows, then 2 sts beg next following 2 rows – 23 sts. Dec 1 st each end next 8 rows – 7 sts. Cast off loosely.

## **COMPLETE**

Join fronts to back at shoulders.

## **HOOD**

With RSF and 5mm needles, beg at right front neck edge (beg of shaping), pick up and k55 sts evenly around entire neck opening (end at beg of shaping of left front).

Work in Brioché Stitch patt for 33cm/13ins.

Cast off loosely.

Join hood seam.

Join side seams.

## **BOTTOM BAND**

With RSF and 5mm needles, pick up and k33 sts across right front cast-on edge, then 63 sts across cast-on edge of back and again 33 sts across left front cast-on edge – 129 sts.

**NR (WS)** – K1; \*p1, k1; rep from \* to end.

Rep this row for Single Moss Stitch until band meas 9cm/3 ½ins from beg.

Cast off loosely.

## **FRONT BAND**

With 5mm needles, cast on 10 sts.

**Row 1 (RS)** – \*P1; k1; rep from \* to end.

**Row 2 (WS)** - \*K1, p1; rep from \* to end.

Rep these 2 rows for Single Moss Stitch until band easily fits from bottom edge of one front to hood centre seam; now work same length again (you will need approx 250-270cm in total).

Sew in place.



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
