# Lace Stole

## in Wendy Fleur DK

Also suitable for any Wendy DK, yarn amounts may vary

### Materials and Measurements

One Colour Stole	2	balls
Three Colour Stole	A	1 ball
	B	1 ball
	C	1 ball
1 - 6.00mm (UK4 - USJ/10) crochet hook. Stitch marker.		
Photographed in shades:- <b>One Colour Stole</b> - 3350 Jasmine. <b>Three Colour Stole - A</b> - 3353 Freesia, <b>B</b> - 3350 Jasmine, <b>C</b> -3352 Clematis.		

Instructions given for smallest size, larger sizes given in brackets. Where only one figure is given this applies to all sizes. Please note that the limitations of the printing process mean the actual colour will not always precisely match the colours in the photograph.

### IMPORTANT

Use only the Wendy yarn specified. We cannot accept responsibility for an imperfect garment if any other brand is used. It is essential to work to the tension stated. The quantities of yarn stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.

### ABBREVIATIONS

**ch** - chain; **dc** - double crochet; **tr** - treble; **dtr** - double treble; **sl st** - slip stitch; **picot** - ch 3, sl st through 2 loops of the st beneath 1st ch; **st** - stitch; **tr2 cl - 2 treble cluster** - yo, pull loop through next st, yo, pull through 2 loops, yo, pull loop through same st, yo, pull through 2 loops; **tr3 cl - 3 treble cluster**- yo, pull through next st, yo, pull through 2 loops, [yo, pull loop through same st, yo, pull through 2 loops] twice, yo, pull through 4 loops; **rept** - repeat; **yo** - yarn over.

### TENSION

It is important to check your tension before commencing the garment. 11 sts x 6 rows to 8cm, 3ins over trebles on 6mm hook. If there are too many stitches to 10cm, then your tension is tight and you will need to change your hook to a larger size. If there are too few stitches to 10cm, then your tension is loose and you will need to change your hook to a smaller size. The shawl is constructed from a series of 12 Panels, which are joined together as work progresses.

### ONE COLOUR STOLE

Work as given for Three Colour Stole using one colour throughout.

### THREE COLOUR STOLE

#### Panel 1

##### Motif 1

**1st row** - Using A, ch 9, sl st to 1st ch to form a ring.

**2nd row** - Ch 3, tr 16 into ring, turn

**3rd row** - Ch 5, [dtr in next st, ch 1] 15 times, dtr in top of ch 3, turn

**4th row** - Ch 4, sl st into 1st ch, [dc in next ch space, dc in next dtr, picot] 15 times, dc into ch 5 loop, dc into 4th ch of ch 5 loop, picot, place a stitch marker in the 11th picot from the beginning of this row, do not turn.

##### Motif 2

**5th row** - Ch 5, sl st into top 2 loops of tr of 1st row, work 2 sl st into side of same tr, sl st into original foundation ring, turn.

**6th row** - Miss 4 sl st, tr 12 into ch-5 space, turn.

**7th row** - Ch 5, [dtr into next st, ch 1] 8 times, dtr in next st, leave next 2 sts unworked, dc into bottom strand of dtr of 2nd row (Motif 1) turn.

**8th row** - Dc into 1st dtr, picot, [dc into ch space, dc into next st, picot] 8 times, dc into last ch 5 loop, dc into 4th ch of ch 5 loop, picot, do not turn.

### Motif 3

**9th row** - Ch 5, sl st into top 2 strands of tr of 5th row, 2 sl st into side of same tr, sl st into ch 5 space from Motif 2 [before picot], turn.

**10th row** - Miss 4 sl st, tr 12 into ch 5 space, turn.

**11th row** - Ch 5, [dtr into next st, ch 1] 8 times, dtr in next st, leave next 2 sts unworked, miss 1st 2 picots, dc into 3rd picot of 7th row (Motif 2) turn.

**12th row** - Dc into dtr, picot, [dc into ch space, dc into next st, picot] 8 times, dc into last ch 5 loop, dc into 4th ch of ch 5 loop, picot, do not turn.

### Motifs 4-7

**13th - 28th rows** - Rept [9th to 12th rows] 4 times, do not turn.

### Motif 8

**29th row** - Ch 6, sl st into top 2 strands of tr of last motif, 2 sl st down side of same tr, sl st into ch 5 space (before picot), turn.

**30th row** - Miss 4 sl st, tr 16 into ch 6 space, turn.

**31st row** - Ch 5, [dtr into next st, ch 1] 12 times, dtr into next st, leave next 2 sts unworked, miss 2 picots, dc into next picot, turn.

**32nd row** - Dc into dtr, picot, [dc into ch space, dc into next st, picot] 12 times, dc into last ch 5 loop, dc into 4th ch of ch 5 loop, picot, miss 2 picots, tr into 3rd picot, fasten off and cut yarn.

### Panel 2

#### Motif 1

Using B, work 1st to 3rd rows as given for 1st Panel Motif 1.

**4th row** - (joining row) Ch 1, tr in 11th picot of 1st Panel Motif 1 (remove stitch marker), ch 1, dc in ch space, of current Motif, dc in next st, ch 1, dtr in 10th picot of 1st Panel Motif 1, ch 1, continue working in current Motif, [dc in ch space, dc in

next st, picot] 14 times, dc in ch 5 loop, dc in 4th ch, picot, place stitch marker in 9th picot from 1st dtr, do not turn.

### **Motif 2**

Rept 5th to 7th rows of 1st Panel Motif 2.

**8th row** - (joining row) Dc into 1st dtr, ch 1, dtr into 12th picot of 1st Panel Motif 1, ch 1, [dc into ch space on current Motif, dc into next st, ch 1, dtr into next picot of 1st Panel Motif 1] twice, ch 1, dtr into next (joining) picot of 1st Panel, ch 1, [dc into ch space on current Motif, dc into next st, ch 1, dtr into next picot of 1st Panel Motif 3] 3 times, ch 1, [dc into ch space, dc into next st, picot] twice, dc into last ch 5 loop, dc into 4th ch of ch 5 loop, picot, do not turn.

### **Motif 3**

**9th row** - Ch 5, sl st into top 2 strands of tr of 5th row, 2 sl st into side of same tr, sl st into ch 5 space from Motif 2 [before picot], turn.

**10th row** - Miss 4 sl st, tr 12 into ch-5 space, turn.

**11th row** - Ch 5, [dtr into next st, ch 1] 8 times, dtr in next st, leave next 2 sts unworked, miss 1st 2 picots, dc into 3rd picot of 7th row (Motif 2) turn.

**12th row** - Dc into dtr, picot, [dc into ch space, dc into next st, picot] 8 times, dc into last ch 5 loop, dc into 4th ch of ch 5 loop, picot, do not turn.

### **Motif 4**

**13th - 15th rows** - Rept 9th to 11th rows of Motif 3.

**16th row** - (joining row) Sl st into same picot, ch 1, dtr into next picot of Panel 1, ch 1, dc into same space on current Motif, dc into ch space, dc into 1st dtr of current Motif, [ch 1, dtr into next picot of Panel 1, ch 1, dc into next ch st of current Motif, dc into next st] 3 times, ch 1, dtr into next (join) picot, ch 1, [dc into next ch space on current motif, dc into next st, ch 1, dtr into next picot, ch 1] 3 times, [dc into next ch space on

current motif, dc into next st, picot], twice, dc into ch 5 loop, dc into 4th ch, picot, do not turn.

### **Motif 5**

**17th - 20th rows** - Rept 9th to 12th rows for Motif 3.

### **Motif 6**

**21st - 24th rows** - Rept 13th to 16th rows for Motif 4.

### **Motif 7**

**25th - 28th rows** - Rept 9th to 12 rows for Motif 3.

### **Motif 8**

**29th - 30th rows** - Rept 29th to 30th rows for Motif 8 Panel 1.

**31st row** - Ch 5, [dtr into next st, ch 1] 12 times, dtr into next st, leave next 2 sts unworked, miss 2 picots, dc into next picot, sl st into same picot, turn.

**32nd row** - (joining row) ch 1, dtr into next picot on Panel 1, ch 1, dc into same space on current motif, dc into next st, [ch 1, dtr into next picot of Panel 1, ch 1, dc into next ch st of current Motif, dc into next st] 3 times, dc into next ch space, dc into next st, ch 1, dtr into next [join] picot on Panel 1, ch 1, dc into ch space, dc into next st, tr into next picot of Panel 1, ch 1, dc into next ch space on current motif, dc into next st, ch 1, dtr into next picot on Panel 1, ch 1, [dc into next ch space on current motif, dc into next st, picot] 7 times, dc into ch 5 loop, dc into 4th chain, picot, miss next 2 picots, tr into 3rd picot, fasten off and cut yarn.

### **Panel 3**

Using B, rept the instructions for Panel 2, joining Motifs 1, 2, 4, 6 and 8 to the picots of Panel 2.

### **Panel 4**

Using C, rept the instructions for Panel 2, joining Motifs 1, 2, 4, 6 and 8 to the picots of Panel 3.

### **Panel 5**

Using B, rept the instructions for Panel 2, joining Motifs 1, 2, 4, 6 and

8 to the picots of Panel 4.

### **Panel 6**

Using C, rept the instructions for Panel 2, joining Motifs 1, 2, 4, 6 and 8 to the picots of Panel 5.

### **Panel 7**

Using C, rept the instructions for Panel 2, joining Motifs 1, 2, 4, 6 and 8 to the picots of Panel 6.

### **Panel 8**

Using A, rept the instructions for Panel 2, joining Motifs 1, 2, 4, 6 and 8 to the picots of Panel 7.

### **Panel 9**

Using C, rept the instructions for Panel 2, joining Motifs 1, 2, 4, 6 and 8 to the picots of Panel 8.

### **Panel 10**

Using A, rept the instructions for Panel 2, joining Motifs 1, 2, 4, 6 and 8 to the picots of Panel 9.

### **Panel 11**

Using A, rept the instructions for Panel 2, joining Motifs 1, 2, 4, 6 and 8 to the picots of Panel 10.

### **Panel 12**

Using B, rept the instructions for Panel 2, joining Motifs 1, 2, 4, 6 and 8 to the picots of Panel 11.

### **Finishing**

Weave in all yarn ends.

Soak your shawl in lukewarm water, gently squeeze to remove excess water and roll up in a clean dry towel (do not wring or rub). Carefully stretch your shawl to the given measurements and pin out on a clean, flat surface. Leave until completely dry.

### **FLOWER FASTENER**

**1st round** - Using B, ch 4, join with sl st to form a circle. Ch 1, dc 8 into the centre of the circle, sl st into 1st dc.

**2nd round** - Ch 3, working in front loops only, tr2 cl in next st, [ch 3, 3 tr cl in next st] 7 times, ch 3, slst to top of 1st petal. Cut yarn and fasten off.

**3rd round** - With right side facing,



working in the loops beneath the tr clusters of 2nd round, join C to any loop between 2 petals, dc into same st, [ch 3, dc into next loop] 7 times, ch 3, sl st into 1st dc. Cut yarn and fasten off.

**4th round** - With wrong side facing, join A to one of the back loops left over from 2nd round, dc into same space, work 1 dc into next 8 loops, sl st into 1st dc, turn.

**5th round** - With right side facing, and working into front loops only, ch 3, tr into next st, [ch 3, 2 tr into next st] 8 times, ch 3, sl st into top of ch 3.

**6th round** - Sl st into next ch 3 space, [dc 1, htr 1, tr 1, htr 1, dc 1 into ch-3 space] 9 times, cut yarn and fasten off.

**7th round** - With wrong side facing, join C to one of the back loops left over from 5th round, dc into same space, work 1 dc into next 9 loops, sl st to 1st dc, turn.

**8th round** - With right side facing, ch 4, dtr 1 into next st, [ch5, dtr 2 into next st] 9 times, sl st into top of ch 4.

**9th round** - Sl st into ch-5 space, [dc 1, htr 1, tr 3, htr 1, dc 1 into ch 5 space] 10 times, cut yarn and fasten off.

## Finishing

Weave in all yarn ends.


Before sewing the button to the back of your flower, place a pencil between the button and your flower to create a 1 cm gap for the button shank. Remove the pencil and weave the 1cm strands together to firm up the shank. Weave in and trim your yarn ends.
