Leave it to Z Project

Project Steering Group Expression of Interest

Young people are often disproportionately affected by natural disasters and other emergencies. Young people also have inherent strengths that aid their resilience and the ability to support their community. Recent events around the world, such as the School Strikes for Climate in Adelaide and globally, Student Volunteer Army following the Christchurch earthquakes and the Florida National School Walkout have delivered powerful examples of the potential of young people to mobilise and be active agents of change and recovery.

Red Cross is seeking expressions of interest from energetic community minded change makers aged between 10 and 25 to be part of the **Leave it to Z** Project Steering Group. The **Leave it to Z** Project will support young people to influence and participate in decision making in emergency preparedness and recovery and drive change in how emergency services and state government work with young people.

The Project Steering Group will provide guidance for the project and the strategy for participation and conversation between young people and emergency services agencies. The Project Steering Group will meet for 2 hours every 2 months for the duration of the project which runs from April 2019 – February 2021. Meetings will be held at Red Cross, 212 Pirie St Adelaide, (after school hours). It is envisioned that the steering group membership will include young people, Red Cross, Commissioner for Children and Young People, SAFECOM, Country Fire Service, Scouts SA and State Emergency Service representatives.

We are looking for young people who are interested in supporting the project as a member of the project steering group. We are looking for young people with experience and/or interest in one or more of the following areas; engaging young people, digital communication with young people, youth advocacy and leadership, emergency preparedness and recovery.
