Peter Kittle Development Receives Approval

At its meeting on 8 October 2018, the Council Assessment Panel considered and subsequently approved the development of a new Peter Kittle Motor Company Showroom and Motor Repair Station on the corner of Main North Road and Gordon Road, Kudla. This particular development application represents the first stage in this site's overall development.

'Council is looking forward to work starting on this site and the positive flow on effects it will have, particularly as it relates to jobs for Gawler people. Peter Kittle will be a great addition to our business community and I extend a warm welcome to their new team.' said Mayor Karen Redman.

This determination follows the preparation of the Commercial and Rural Areas Development Plan Amendment, in which Council successfully rezoned this parcel of land in February this year to support this particular development. This Development Plan Amendment was initially instigated following conversations with the State Coordinator General, who wished to see Council and the Peter Kittle Motor Group work collaboratively to develop this site in order to generate employment opportunities within the region.

"We are thrilled to receive approval for our proposed development, as it will facilitate the expansion of our service into Gawler, which is a key service centre for communities to the north. We are now looking forward to commencing construction and ultimately opening our doors for business as soon as possible. Gawler is a fantastic township and we look forward to making a positive contribution to the local community" said Andrew Kittle, CEO Peter Kittle Motor Company.

The new Showroom and Motor Repair Station is a significant investment by the Peter Kittle Motor Group and is anticipated to provide substantial economic benefit for both Gawler and the wider region. It will initially provide economic stimulus through its 36 month construction phase, and then, once completed, Stage 1 operations will generate approximately 45 new ongoing jobs within Gawler and the automotive industry.
