Town of Gawler Draft Walking and Cycling Plan 2018-2028

The purpose of the Draft Walking and Cycling Plan 2018-2028 is to enable people of all ages and abilities across the Town of Gawler to choose walking and/or cycling as a regular day-to-day activity for transport or recreation, and further promote the Town of Gawler as a unique, vibrant and accessible tourist destination.

This Plan was developed by undertaking an extensive analysis of the existing walking and cycling environment (through demographics, site visits, and data) and integrating this information with guidance from Elected Members, staff, stakeholders and the community. This process helped identify the barriers to walking and cycling uptake and opportunities to enhance the walking and cycling environment for all residents across the Town of Gawler.

Mayor Karen Redman said, "The Plan incorporates a long term vision for our walking and cycling network, as well as a 10-year Action Plan for priority works. The recommendations made in this report are based on safety, connectivity, permeability, amenity, access for all abilities, tourism and planning for future growth". Many residents in Gawler are keen walkers and cyclists so I encourage all who are interested to check out the report and provide feedback on this important strategic document".

The community consultation period for Town of Gawler draft Walking and Cycling Plan 2018-2028 will conclude at 5pm Friday 13 April 2018.
